Deuteronomy 6:4

Isaiah 45:21-22

*Declare and present your case; let them take counsel together!*

*Who told this long ago? Who declared it of old? Was it not I, the LORD? And there is no other god besides me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is none besides me. "Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.*

Another truth claim, "For I am God, and there is no other."

Do I accept that claim of total exclusivity or do I insist on substituting one of the panoplies of gods created by the mind of man? Am I willing to surrender all to the LORD, God the Almighty or will I continue to depend upon a final end that is dependent upon my weak and failing performance?

Thursday, 21 January 2015

1 Timothy 2:5

*For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,*

One God and one path to Him. John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. Hallelujah, I don't have to worry about which mediator is the best way to approach the LORD, God the Almighty--there is only one path that leads to the one true God.

Friday, 22 January 2015

Exodus 6:6-7, 11

*Say therefore to the people of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from slavery to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment. I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. ... "Go in, tell Pharaoh king of Egypt to let the people of Israel go out of his land."*

Or more succinctly, the majesty of the Almighty vs. the magisterium of Pharaoh. Pharaoh had no inkling, not a whisper of an idea that he, the most powerful monarch in the world, was face to face with the representative of the LORD, God the Almighty. That representative, a member of a slave people and a menial shepherd, demanded that he kowtow to an unknown god.

Majesty trumps!

Job 37:22

*Out of the north comes golden splendor; God is clothed with awesome majesty.*

Awesome majesty--a majesty that inspires fear, that causes apprehension and induces great admiration. A majesty that caused Isaiah to fall on his face and cry, "Woe is me!...for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts."

unclean lips, dwelling in the midst of a people of unclean lips. Isaiah 6:5 Let us vow to only apply awesome to the LORD, God the Almighty, the One who is truly awe-inspiring.
